1719	AN ACT TO PREVENT UNJUST ENRICHMENT BY RETENTION OF SURPLUS UPON FORECLOSURE OF MUNICIPALITIES AND SEWER DISTRICTS	Najarian

1818	AN ACT TO CLARIFY THAT NOTARIES PUBLIC WHO DO NOT MAINTAIN A SEAL OF OFFICE MAY TAKE ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS	Hobbins	PL 1983, c. 635
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SUMMARY: Deleted requirement that certain acknowledgements be taken before a notary having a seal. A 1981 law removed the requirement that a notary have a seal. Also removed references to foreign notaries since the Uniform Acknowledgements Act already addresses that issue.

1819	AN ACT TO REENACT A PROVISION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDERS IN CRIMES BETWEEN FAMILY MEMBERS	Mitchell, E	PL 1983, c. 619 (EMERGENCY)
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SUMMARY: The Family Abuse Law was enacted in 1980 with several sunset provisions. Parts of this law were reallocated and new sunset provisions were added, reallocated, and repealed. Subsequently all of the sunset provisions were repealed except, inadvertently, the one concerning protective orders. Thus, the protective order portion of the Family Abuse Law repealed. This law reenacts those repealed provisions.
