- SUMMARY of LD 390: Established special procedure for arbitration for police and fire departments and a new chapter with penalties for illegal strikes; arbitrators must be Maine residents; establishes binding arbitration on salaries, pensions or insurance.
- SUMMARY of LD 1724-Provides special arbitration procedures to apply to emergency service personnel; arbitrator's decision is binding on all issues rather than only on noneconomic issues.

PL 1983, c. 486 (ND of LD 1629)

SUMMARY of LD 1629: Any entity in willful or repeated violation of health and safety standards shall be barred from participation in state

- SUMMARY of LD 1742: Dept. of Labor shall, after hearing, debar employer from participating in state contracts for 2 years if the employer has committed a serious, willful violation or serious, repeated violations of federal OSHA standards or the state's chemical substance identification laws.
- AN ACT TO ADOPT FEDERAL OPTIONS 1752 Prav eng.w/o ref. Beaulieu IN THE UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION to comm. EXTENDED BENEFIT PROGRAM PL 1983, c. 491 (emerg.)
- SUMMARY: Under other statutes, recipients of unemployment compensation must actively seek work to receive extended or federal supplemental benefits and there is no good cause exception; this bill adopts a new federal exception for persons unable to actively seek work because of jury duty or hospitalization for emergency or life-threatening conditions.
