1835 AN ACT PROHIBITING RELEASE Hichens OTP-ND OF ANIMALS BY STATE HUMANE PL 1983, C. 621

AGENTS FOR EXPERIMENTATION OR VIVISECTION PURPOSES

SUMMARY: Replaced by LD 2052. See LD 2052.

OTP 2028 RESOLVE, ESTABLISHING A FOOD POLICY FOR MAINE PL 1983, C. 51

SUMMARY: Establishes a Food Policy for Maine which was drafted after an extensive study by the Agriculture Committee in off-session which documented Maine's heavy reliance on imported food from other states (70%) and which determined Maine's food production potential. The food policy acknowledged the contribution that agriculture makes to Maine's economy and community life, and it encourages more production of food which can be grown efficiently and competitively.

2052 AN ACT PROHIBITING RELEASE OF Hichens OTP-ND PL 1983, C. 621 ANIMALS BY STATE HUMANE AGENTS FOR EXPERIMENTATION OR VIVI-SECTION PURPOSES

SUMMARY: Prohibits the transfer of animals from humane societies, shelters, and animal care centers to laboratories and medical centers for the purpose of vivisection and experimentation.

2149 AN ACT RELATING TO CHANGES IN Erwin, E. THE COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONING PL 1983, C. 834 OF THE HARNESS RACING COMMISSION

Increases membership on the Harness Racing Commission from SUMMARY: 3 to 5 Commissioners with the added condition that appointments made by the Governor shall reflect broad geographic distribution of the State. An additional appropriation of \$7,200 is included to meet added expenses for a larger Commission. Section 3 of the bill was striken by House Amendment 600 which would have allowed the Harness Racing Commission to avoid consideration of minor, frivolous appeals concerning rule infractions.
