LD TITLE SPONSOR DISPOSITION

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE PUBLIC Baker OTP-ND UTILITIES COMMISSION TO RETURN Handy See LD 2088 TO FIRM CUSTOMERS THE PROFITS Pouliot FROM SALES OF GAS TO INTER-Brannigan RUPTIBLE USERS

SUMMARY: Present law allows sales of gas to interruptible (i.e., non-firm) users at a discount below the year-round average rate normally charged. The bill allows the PUC to flow through the profits (if any) in such sales to reduce the rates of all customers.

1905 AN ACT ALLOWING REVENUES FROM McGowan LV/WD INTERRUPTIBLE GAS SALES TO BE Ridley CREDITED TO THE COST OF GAS Handy

SUMMARY: Present law allows sales of gas to interruptible (i.e., non-firm) customers at a discount below the year-round average rate normally charged. The bill would allow PUC to include sales of gas to interruptible customers when they reconcile the actual fuel costs with the estimated fuel costs used to establish base gas rates.

1927 AN ACT TO CLARIFY PENALTIES Kany LV/WD FOR VIOLATION OF THE PUBLIC Baker UTILITIES INSIDER LAW Ridley Paradis, E.

SUMMARY: The bill amends the law requiring reports to the PUC regarding insider transactions so that the penalty would apply to all violataions, rather than just violations that are willful.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING PENALTIES Baker OTP-ND FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE DISCON- Mayo See LD 2288 NECTION AND DEPOSIT REGULATIONS Baldacci OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COM- Matthews, Z. MISSION

SUMMARY: The bill would permit the PUC to impose a fine of not more than \$500 for a utility which violates the deposit and disconnection regulations established by the Commission.

1962 AN ACT RELATING TO THE PLACE- Violette LV/WD MENT OF POLES BY UTILITIES Soule Robinson

SUMMARY: The bill would limit the right of injured persons to sue a utility for damages resulting from improper installation, location or maintenance of utility facilities.
