SUMMARY:

2133 RESOLVE, AUTHORIZING THE BU- MacEachern LV/WD REAU OF PUBLIC LANDS TO CONVEY THE STATE'S TITLE TO CERTAIN LAND IN GRAND FALLS TO THE GRAND FALLS HISTORICAL SOCIETY

SUMMARY: LD 2133 proposed to transfer the title to a one room school house in Grand Falls from the Bureau of Public Lands to the Grand Falls Historical Society. The Bureau of Public Lands (BPL) was opposed to the bill because the BPL preferred a lease arrangement or at least a reverter clause. In addition, the Historical Society did not wish to cover the building with insurance. As a result, the bill was withdrawn.
