

1937 AN ACT CONCERNING THE POS-SESSION OF FIREARMS BY FELONS Diamond, G. Swazey Cox

PL 1983, c. 618

Repeals Title 15, Sec. 392 which grants convicted felons an exemption to the general law prohibiting felons from possessing firearms if they are employed as law enforcement officers or by a watch, guard or patrol agency. This repeal puts Maine law in conformity with Title 25 which does not allow felons to attend the Police Academy to train for law enforcement positions and the Federal Gun Control Act of 1968 which prohibits felons from carrying firearms unless they obtain a hard-to-get federal permit.

SUMMARY: LD 2113, as amended by Committee Amendment "A" and Senate Amendment "B" to C.A."A", provides for a special license for Maine farm wineries which use Maine products to make 50,000 gallons of wine or less annually. The licensee is responsible for an excise tax which is less than that on other wines.
