SUMMARY: Requires disclosure in the contract of certain health hazards of this type of insulation and those measures, if any, which the contractor will take to correct any problems.

SUMMARY: Adds fleets, commercial vehicles and vehicles weighing 8,500 pounds or more to the "Lemon Law."

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A"(H-558): With respect to vehicles weighing 8,500 pounds or more, abandons requirement that vehicle be returned for service twice to the same agent or dealer. For some vehicles, provides for liability of component manufacturers in some cases.(McHenry). (H: Adopted)

SUMMARY: Requires commercial establishments with microwave ovens to prominently display a notice of that fact.

SUMMARY: Exempts from the "billboard law" (Maine Traveler Information Services Act) temporary farm market sale signs; preempts stricter local ordinances.
