SUPPRESSION PROJECT

SUMMARY: Would establish cost at \$7,500,000. See LD 2233.

AN ACT CONCERNING IMPLEMENTA Higgins, H OTP-ND LD2122 1989 TION OF THE BOAT EXCISE TAX

SUMMARY: Original bill postponed implementation of municipal watercraft excise tax for one year to permit constitutional amendment to be resubmitted to the people. See LD 2122

1990 AN ACT TO CREATE A MAINE Smith, C.B LV/WD STATE INCOME TAX EXEMPTION FOR TAXPAYERS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS DEPENDENTS

SUMMARY: Would provide an additional income tax exemption for handicapped dependents.

AN ACT TO REVISE THE FOREST Kany 2000 LV/WD FIRE SUPPRESSION TAX

SUMMARY: Would remove September 1, 1985 one acre reporting requirement. See LD 2474.

2005 AN ACT TO CREATE A WATER-Scarpino REP LV/WD CRAFT USER FEE

SUMMARY: Would establish commercial watercraft excise tax equal to 10% respect of Maine income tax with to the watercraft. Non-commercial boats would remain subject to property tax.
