SUMMARY: Allows the board to conduct investigatory hearings and subpoena confidential information; provides immunity for complainants and others who provide information or assistance in good faith.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" (S-361): Copies of confidential information given to licensee; immunity for complainants removed. (Adopted)

SUMMARY: Establishes a license board and procedure for massage therapists.

2042 AN ACT CONCERNING EXAMINA- Pray LV/WD H&S:Accepted TIONS FOR LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSES.

SUMMARY: Provides for 2 years of practical experience as an equivalent to 4 years of education in order to take the examination.

CROSS-REFERENCE: LD 34, First Regular Session, identical except for a 3-year experience requirement.
