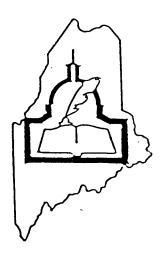

SUMMARY: LD 2121 allocated funds to various highway programs from the surplus revenues generated by the increase in the fuel tax. A total of \$3,146,315 was allocated to administration, maintenance and operations, highway bond retirement and interest, and the collector road program for the 1983-85 biennium.

As a result of a roughly \$7,000,000 surplus, as well as other bills to be funded from the highway fund totalling roughly \$5,000,000, two new drafts were prepared, LD 2443 and LD 2444.
