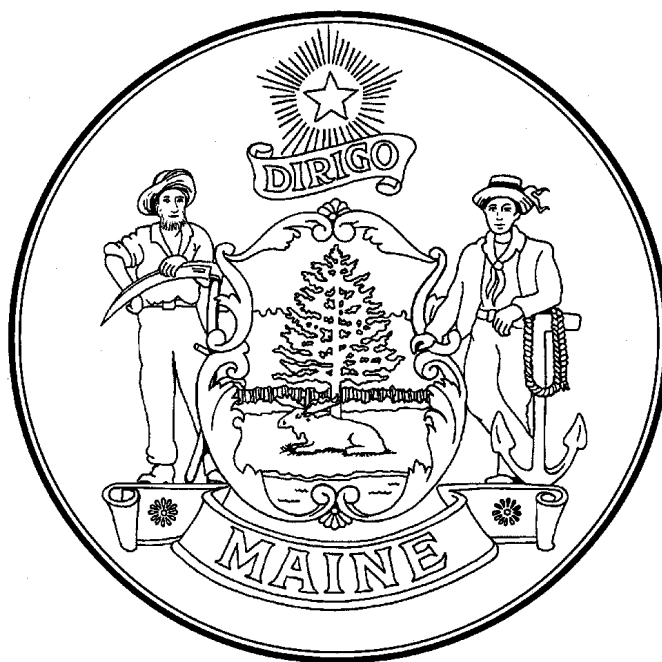

SUMMARY:

The bill creates a Maine Self-Service Storage Act, based on a model developed by a national trade association, to regulate the use of leased space at self-service storage facilities. The purpose of the act is to give the facility's operator a lien on personal property stored on the premises for rent, labor or other charges and to allow the operator to sell the property at a public or private sale.

The original bill increases the returnable container handling fee from 2 cents to 3 cents per container returned. The committee amendment (S-103) increased it to 1 1/4 cents.
