This Act ties into the Municipal General Assistance statute. Under this statute municipalities are required to have a general assistance program.

In the case of burial expenses of an eligible person, the overseer has 10 days to make a decision on the application for payment of burial expenses. In addition to parents and grandparents who are held responsible for a person's basic needs of all types, children and grandchildren are held responsible for burial expenses.

This Act repeals all the current burial provisions. It merely requires that the overseer be notified prior to making burial preparations and does not require approval. In addition, it specifically mentions other parties liable for burial expenses, including federal and state programs, e.g. social security. Finally, it indicates what types of expenses will be covered and specifies a dollar ceiling of \$650 for all expenses except cemetery lot and internment.
