SUMMARY:
This bill permits municipal officials to enforce State fire laws and municipal ordinances through filing of a civil violation. A provision is included for notice and opportunity for the municipality or the State to join any litigation which challenges the validity of an ordinance or State law or rule.
Committee Amendment "A" (H-42) changes the location of the new language to a more appropriate chapter within the fire protection laws.
