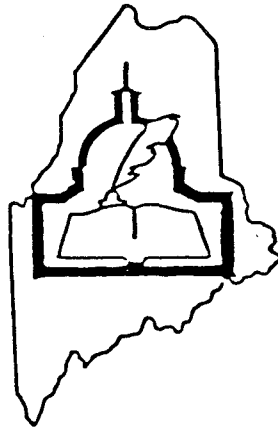

Permits the voluntary hospitalization of nonobjecting adults under guardianship.

SUMMARY:

Sought to provide:

1. For the sale of a motor vehicle, including a motor driven cycle, snowmobile or an all-terrain vehicle, used in the commission of a theft crime in order to make restitution to the victim; and
2. That any person convicted of a theft crime committed with a motor vehicle would lose their operators license for one year.

SUMMARY:

The 111th Legislature abolished the distinction among court intake workers, probation officers who supervised juveniles, and after-care workers of the Maine Youth Center. It consolidated the responsibilities of these 3 functions and assigned them to a newly-defined class of employees

denominated as juvenile caseworkers. This bill sought to amend these provisions of the Maine Revised Statutes, Titles 15 and 34-A which refer to intake workers, etc., to reflect the change in terminology. These changes are incorporated in LD 1069.

Sought to require residents of a nursing home or hospital to see and sign a disclosure before transferring property. The disclosure form was to advise of the potential significance of such a transfer and of the possibility of retaining a life estate.
