If the amendment was adopted in the House, the letter H appears after the sponsor. If it was adopted in the Senate, the letter S appears.

Final action for each bill is listed to the right of the title. If final House action and Senate action differ, both are listed.

SUMMARY: Held over from First Regular Session. Doubles the Alcohol Premium Tax for funding alcoholism programs. Amendment adopted which provides that future allocations from the Alcoholism Education, Prevention, Treatment and Research Fund will be referred to the Appropriations Committee and provides for transfer from the Alcoholism Fund to the General Fund to reimburse it for losses due to decreased liquor purchases.. New draft (minority Committee report) undedicating that Alcoholism Fund was not accepted.

SUMMARY: This bill attempted to require the Department of Transportation to pay municipalities for unpaid taxes on property acquired by the Department by placing a lien on the property. It was withdrawn because the procedure in the bill would not accomplish the desired result and the sponsor was attempting to reach an agreement with the Department.
