Seeks to require any hearing conducted by the Board of Bar Overseers on charges of attorney misconduct to be open to the public.

SUMMARY:

Clarifies the meaning of the so-called "voluntary social companion" defense, which reduces the penalty for the crimes of rape and gross sexual misconduct. This makes it clear that the defense is available both when the victim voluntarily allows the defendant sexual contact, the defendant thus being the actor, and when the victim voluntarily performs a sexual contact upon the defendant, the victim thus being the actor.

Also amends the "voluntary intoxication" defense to a prosecution for gross sexual misconduct to make the defense unavailable in the instance where the actor, for example, a doctor or dentist, administers or employs the substance under circumstances where the person who voluntarily acquiesces possesses a reasonable belief that this is for the purpose of medical or dental examination or treatment.

SUMMARY:

Permits deputy attorneys general and deputy district attorneys to request a court to order a public utility to provide access to public utility subscriber information. Current law permits only the Attorney General to make this request.

SUMMARY:

Permits a competent individual 18 years old or older to execute a declaration, i.e., a living will, directing the withdrawal or withholding of life-sustaining procedures. The declaration must be signed by the declarant, or another at his direction, in the presence of 2 witnesses who must also sign the declaration.

A physician or health care provider who is given a copy of the declaration must make it a part of the declarant's medical record.

The declaration is to be given operative effect only when:

- 1. It is communicated to the attending physician;
- 2. The declarant is determined to be in a terminal condition by the attending physician; and
- The declarant is unable to make treatment decisions.

The Act also provides a model form for a declaration and addresses the responsibilities and liabilities of persons involved in carrying out, or in the revocation of, a declaration.
