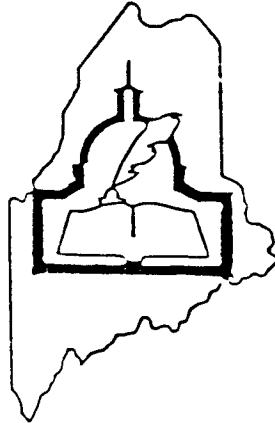

This bill would have permitted the transfer of milk from plant to plant for bottling or packaging because of equipment breakdowns. This proposal was opposed by the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources because of a concern about potential health risks, especially the danger of Salmonella outbreak.

This new draft makes revisions to the statutes establishing the cooperative extension service in Maine. Many changes needed to be made to update

provisions related to budget and county taxes and to make accurate reference to titles of programs and institutions.

This was a proposal to limit harness racing wagering to agricultural fair associations only. The cotention of the sponsor was that wagering at harness racing meets appeared to be cutting into potential revenue from the State lottery.

The purpose of this law is to allow the use of botanical pesticides in the production of foods labeled or advertised as organic, organically grown or biologically grown. The sponsors of the bill were interested in bringing Maine's organic labeling law into closer compliance with the practices suggested by the International Federation of Organic Agricultural Movements and other organizations representing organic growers.
