Replaces Maine's current statutes permitting governmental bodies and nonprofit corporations to hold conservation easements (which conserve the natural character of land to which the easement applies by limiting, e.g., building) that are not held in connection with another piece of Adopts the Uniform Conservation Easement Act, which more clearly defines what entities may hold conservation easements without the requirement of benefit to another piece of land owned by the holder; the purposes for which these easements may be held; and the rights and duties of the holder and grantor of the easement with regard to the terms of the easement, its enforcement, and its termination.
