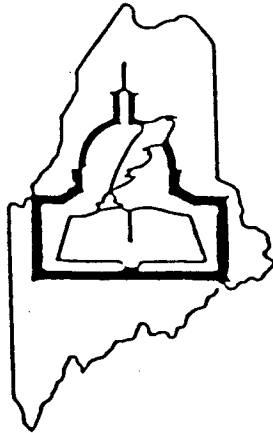

This document is a compilation of the bill summaries prepared by this office for the Joint Standing Committees and Joint Select Committees of the Maine Legislature, covering the Second Regular Session of the 112th Legislature. The summaries are arranged by LD number under each committee.

All Amendments are listed, by paper number (e.g., H-584 or S-222), together with the sponsor if it is a floor amendment or the designation "CA" if it is a committee amendment. If the amendment was adopted in the House, the letter H appears after the sponsor. If it was adopted in the Senate, the letter S appears.

Final action for each bill is listed to the right of the title. If final House action and Senate action differ, both are listed.

LD 1691 AN ACT RELATING TO PENOBSCOT NATION GAME WARDENS ND LD 2190

LD 1713 AN ACT TO AMEND THE DATE ON WHICH QUARTERLY CAMPAIGN REPORTS ARE DUE PL 1985 c. 566

H-515 CA H S

SUMMARY: This bill extends the date on which the quarterly campaign financing report is due to the 15th day, instead of the 1st day, of the next quarter.

The Committee Amendment changes the due date of all gubernatorial and other candidates' quarterly campaign reports to the 15th day of the quarter. In addition, the first quarterly report is not due until the 15th day of the quarter which begins at least 90 days after the election.

LD 1769 AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAWS RELATING TO INVESTIGATIVE INFORMATION OF THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL'S OFFICE PL 1985 c. 552 EMERGENCY

H-497 CA H S

SUMMARY: This bill clarifies that information in the custody of the office of State Fire Marshal may not be released if it would hinder law enforcement proceedings or cause problems in certain enumerated areas.
