JOINT STANDING COMMITTEE BILL SUMMARIES MAY 1986

This document is a compilation of the bill summaries prepared by this office for the Joint Standing Committees and Joint Select Committees of the Maine Legislature, covering the Second Regular Session of the 112th Legislature. The summaries are arranged by LD number under each committee.

All Amendments are listed, by paper number (e.g., H-584 or S-222), together with the sponsor if it is a floor amendment or the designation "CA" if it is a committee amendment. If the amendment was adopted in the House, the letter H appears after the sponsor. If it was adopted in the Senate, the letter S appears.

Final action for each bill is listed to the right of the title. If final House action and Senate action differ, both are listed.

The procedure was contingent upon joint agreement by both the applicant and the DEP. The Committee granted the sponsor a leave to withdraw report.

Sponsor: MURPHY, E., Farnum, Handy, Tuttle Committee Report: ONTP

SUMMARY: This bill would have required any solid or hazardous waste disposal facility which intends or begins to accept waste generated outside the municipality in which it is located to notify the municipal officers of its intent or action. Within 90 days of that notice, the municipality would have been required to hold a referendum on the acceptance of waste from outside the municipality. The results of the vote were to have been sent to the BEP. The Committee felt that sufficient public participation provisions already exist in law and that matters such as this could be better handled through municipal zoning ordinances.
