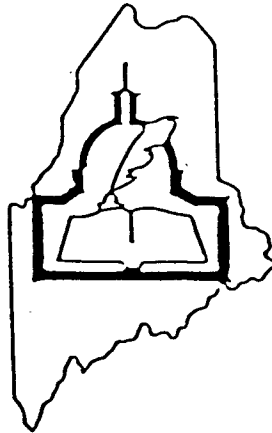

This document is a compilation of the bill summaries prepared by this office for the Joint Standing Committees and Joint Select Committees of the Maine Legislature, covering the Second Regular Session of the 112th Legislature. The summaries are arranged by LD number under each committee.

All Amendments are listed, by paper number (e.g., H-584 or S-222), together with the sponsor if it is a floor amendment or the designation "CA" if it is a committee amendment. If the amendment was adopted in the House, the letter H appears after the sponsor. If it was adopted in the Senate, the letter S appears.

Final action for each bill is listed to the right of the title. If final House action and Senate action differ, both are listed.

LD 1820 AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE APPLICABILITY OF THE MAINE TORT CLAIMS ACT ND LD 2142

LD 1844 AN ACT TO EXTEND THE TRUST LAND DESIGNATION OF THE PENOBSCOT NATION PL 1985 c. 639

SUMMARY: LD 1844 extends the time for designation of Penobscot Nation trust land to April 1, 1988. It also adds to the land that may become trust land any 300 acres within the City of Old Town agreed upon by the Penobscot Nation and the City, provided that the agreement must be finalized prior to August 31, 1991.

LD 1856 AN ACT RELATING TO TAKING OF LAND UNDER THE COASTAL ISLAND REGISTRY LAW LVWD

SUMMARY: This bill sought to allow a person claiming ownership of a coastal island to recover legal and other expenses incurred in establishing the person's claim when the island property is erroneously taken by the State under the Maine Coastal Island Registry law.

LD 1859 AN ACT TO RESOLVE A CONFLICT IN THE LAW DEALING WITH THE CRIME OF GROSS SEXUAL MISCONDUCT PL 1985 c. 544

Sponsor: KANE
Committee Report: OTP

SUMMARY: LD 1859 clears up a conflict between two bills, enacted last year, which amended the crime of gross sexual misconduct. The marital rape bill eliminated from this crime the defense of a man and woman living together at the time of the crime. A later bill dealing with sex offense
