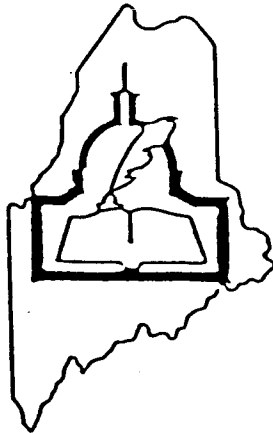

This document is a compilation of the bill summaries prepared by this office for the Joint Standing Committees and Joint Select Committees of the Maine Legislature, covering the Second Regular Session of the 112th Legislature. The summaries are arranged by LD number under each committee.

All Amendments are listed, by paper number (e.g., H-584 or S-222), together with the sponsor if it is a floor amendment or the designation "CA" if it is a committee amendment. If the amendment was adopted in the House, the letter H appears after the sponsor. If it was adopted in the Senate, the letter S appears.

Final action for each bill is listed to the right of the title. If final House action and Senate action differ, both are listed.

LD 1848 AN ACT TO PROVIDE GREATER COMMUNITY INPUT INTO ALCOHOL AND DRUG PLANNING LVWD

Sponsor: BUSTIN
Committee Report: LVWD

SUMMARY: This bill sought to add 2 community representatives to the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Planning Committee. It was rereferred to the Joint Select Committee on Alcoholism Services and eventually withdrawn.

LD 1858 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES, WHEN REVIEWING CERTIFICATE OF NEED APPLICATIONS FROM HEALTH FACILITIES LOCATED NEAR THE STATE BORDER, CONSIDER THE IMPACT FROM HOSPITALS LOCATED OUTSIDE THE STATE LVWD

Sponsor: ROLDE
Committee Report: LVWD

SUMMARY: This bill was intended to require the Department of Human Services to consider the potential gains from that project because of out-of-state patients use. This bill was withdrawn but its intent was included in the amendments to LD 2018. See LD 2018 for further details of the final version of this proposal.

LD 1870 AN ACT TO AMEND THE QUARTERLY REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR MUNICIPALITIES NOT RECEIVING GENERAL ASSISTANCE REIMBURSEMENTS PL 1985 c. 567

Committee Report: OTP-A

H-518 CA H S

SUMMARY: This bill sought to repeal the provision requiring quarterly general assistance reports from municipalities not receiving general assistance reimbursements. The committee amendment (H-518) replaced the original bill. It changed the quarterly reporting requirement to an annual reporting requirement.
