All Amendments are listed, by paper number (e.g., H-584 or S-222), together with the sponsor if it is a floor amendment or the designation "CA" if it is a committee amendment. If the amendment was adopted in the House, the letter H appears after the sponsor. If it was adopted in the Senate, the letter S appears.

Final action for each bill is listed to the right of the title. If final House action and Senate action differ, both are listed.

SUMMARY: This bill sought to have all payments received
for the boarding of prisoners placed in a fund which would
only be used for improvement and operation of the county
jails.

In the previous session, a similar bill had been introduced
for Somerset County except that it specified a dollar
amount rather than requiring the placement of all payments
to the fund. However, this bill was passed with an
amendment that provided the requested funds from the
General Fund rather than from the boarding of prisoners.

The Committee felt that LD 2026 infringed on the budget
rights of the County Commissioners and the Legislative
Delegation.
