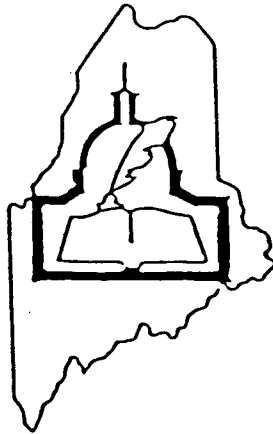

This document is a compilation of the bill summaries prepared by this office for the Joint Standing Committees and Joint Select Committees of the Maine Legislature, covering the Second Regular Session of the 112th Legislature. The summaries are arranged by LD number under each committee.

All Amendments are listed, by paper number (e.g., H-584 or S-222), together with the sponsor if it is a floor amendment or the designation "CA" if it is a committee amendment. If the amendment was adopted in the House, the letter H appears after the sponsor. If it was adopted in the Senate, the letter S appears.

Final action for each bill is listed to the right of the title. If final House action and Senate action differ, both are listed.

SUMMARY: This bill proposed procedural changes to speed the processing of applications delegated by the BEP to the Commissioner. The Committee unanimously approved the bill with an amendment (CAH-553) reducing the proposed maximum time allowed for processing delegated application processing from 105 to 80 days.

SUMMARY: This bill proposed including additional portions of the Crooked River in the provisions of the 1983 "Rivers Bill" that provide protection against various forms of development. The bill also provided for a prohibition on hydropower for the Crooked River. See also LD 1893. The Committee gave the bill a unanimous "leave to withdraw" report due to concerns that the subject was not being approached in a comprehensive manner.
