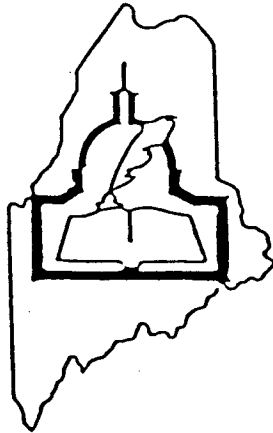

This document is a compilation of the bill summaries prepared by this office for the Joint Standing Committees and Joint Select Committees of the Maine Legislature, covering the Second Regular Session of the 112th Legislature. The summaries are arranged by LD number under each committee.

All Amendments are listed, by paper number (e.g., H-584 or S-222), together with the sponsor if it is a floor amendment or the designation "CA" if it is a committee amendment. If the amendment was adopted in the House, the letter H appears after the sponsor. If it was adopted in the Senate, the letter S appears.

Final action for each bill is listed to the right of the title. If final House action and Senate action differ, both are listed.

LD 2192 AN ACT ALLOWING LICENSEES TO PURCHASE LIQUOR FROM AGENCY LIQUOR STORES IF LICENSEE IS LOCATED MORE THAN 20 MILES FROM STATE LIQUOR STORES INDEF PP

SUMMARY: The original bill permits licensees to buy liquor from agency stores and reinstates the 10% (net 8%) discount to licensees. Current law requires all liquor licensees to buy the liquor they resell from the State Liquor Commission. The new draft allows those licensees located far from state liquor stores to purchase liquor from closer agency stores.

Fiscal note of a loss of \$100,000 for FY 1986-87.
