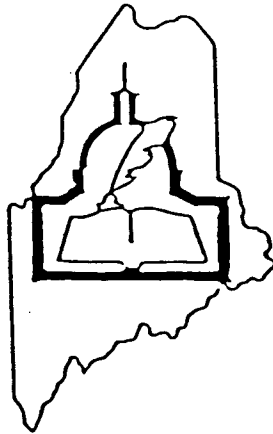

This document is a compilation of the bill summaries prepared by this office for the Joint Standing Committees and Joint Select Committees of the Maine Legislature, covering the Second Regular Session of the 112th Legislature. The summaries are arranged by LD number under each committee.

All Amendments are listed, by paper number (e.g., H-584 or S-222), together with the sponsor if it is a floor amendment or the designation "CA" if it is a committee amendment. If the amendment was adopted in the House, the letter H appears after the sponsor. If it was adopted in the Senate, the letter S appears.

Final action for each bill is listed to the right of the title. If final House action and Senate action differ, both are listed.

SUMMARY: The new draft establishes a comprehensive revision of the water quality classification system. A new system of water quality classes and standards is established and waters of the state are reclassified to fit the new system. Extensive files on the development and content of the bill are available in the legislative Office of Policy and Legal Analysis. The new draft also requires that all rules related to the licensing of hydropower be reviewed by the Energy and Natural Resources Committee prior to becoming effective. The Committee unanimously approved the new draft.
