

This document is a compilation of the bill summaries prepared by this office for the Joint Standing Committees and Joint Select Committees of the Maine Legislature, covering the Second Regular Session of the 112th Legislature. The summaries are arranged by LD number under each committee.

All Amendments are listed, by paper number (e.g., H-584 or S-222), together with the sponsor if it is a floor amendment or the designation "CA" if it is a committee amendment. If the amendment was adopted in the House, the letter H appears after the sponsor. If it was adopted in the Senate, the letter S appears.

Final action for each bill is listed to the right of the title. If final House action and Senate action differ, both are listed.

<u>SUMMARY:</u> This bill which was referred to the Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs set up a bond issue vote on \$7.7M for various projects at University of Maine campuses.

CA-H-697: The Committee Amendment increased the bond authorization to \$12.1M to provide for construction of facilities in the Lewiston-Auburn area.

The bill was recommitted to the Appropriations Committee in the final days of the session following passage of a Joint Order requesting the Board of Trustees of the University to conduct a study of the costs of capital construction in Lewiston-Auburn, York County and Augusta. Following receipt of the report, the bill will be reconsidered at the Special Session this summer.
