LD 336 AN ACT TO AMEND THE STATE EMPLOYEE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING ACT ONTP

SUMMARY: LD 336 proposed to allow binding arbitration on all subjects of collective bargaining, including economic issues, under the State Employee Collective Bargaining Act.

LD 343 AN ACT TO REPEAL CERTAIN STATUTES RELATING TO CONTINUED GROUP HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE LVWD

SUMMARY: LD 343 proposed to repeal the laws requiring employers to offer continuation of group health benefits to employees when temporarily laid-off or out on workers' compensation.

LD 363 AN ACT TO MAKE STATE LAW REGARDING CONTINUATION OF GROUP HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE CONSISTENT WITH FEDERAL LAW LVWD

Sponsor: MANNING, Racine
Committee Report: LVWD

SUMMARY: LD 363 proposed to amend the laws requiring employers to offer continuation of group health benefits to employees when temporarily laid-off or out on workers' compensation so that the maximum rate chargeable to employees for the continued coverage was consistent with the maximum allowable charge under Federal law.
