AN ACT TO INCREASE THE STATE'S SHARE OF
EDUCATION COSTS.

CARRY-OVER

SUMMARY: At present the state's share of allowable costs in the school subsidy formula is 55%. The bill would have increased the percentage state share first to 60% and then to 65% by 1991-92.

KINDERGARTEN ELIGIBILITY.

SUMMARY: The intent of this bill was to change the date by which a child entering first grade or a one or two-year kindergarten, must turn 6, 5, or 4, respectively, from October 15th of the year the child enters school to the July 15th preceding the start of the school year. The committee recommended passage of LD 1505 creating the Special Commission to Study School Entrance Age.
