LD 368 AN ACT TO ALLOW A COUNTY TREASURER TO APPOINT A DEPUTY TREASURER ONTP

Sponsor: ANDERSON, Lord, Matthews, K., Collins

SUMMARY: Currently county officials must submit the names of any person they plan to hire to the county commissioners for their approval.

This bill seeks to remove the treasurer from the necessity of obtaining commissioner approval of the employment of a deputy.

LD 420 AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE TAXING POWERS OF THE FRYE ISLAND MUNICIPAL SERVICES CORPORATION ND LD 738

LD 457 AN ACT CONCERNING DELINQUENT DOG LICENSES LVWD

Sponsor: RACINE, Black, Kimball
Committee Report: LVWD

SUMMARY: Current law requires that owners of unlicensed dogs receive a court summons. Before it is issued the control officer is required to call on the dog's owner to request his conforming with the law. A person licensing his dog after receiving this warning is charged an additional \$4 which is turned over to the control officer.

This bill would allow the owner to be informed by certified mail.
