SUMMARY: The bill has been held over by the Committee. It provides for reimbursement to municipalities for 90% of the property tax loss resulting from tree growth classification.

Imposes a tax on the possession of illegal drugs.

SUMMARY: Original bill provides sales tax exemption for nonprofit educational foundations providing summer programs about drugs and alcohol in a camp setting for young people.
