LD 909 AN ACT RELATING TO ALLOWING LOCAL PLANNING BOARDS TO REQUIRE A SUBDIVISION APPLICANT TO SET ASIDE 20% OF LOTS TO BE SOLD AT 25% BELOW FAIR MARKET VALUE.

ONTP

Sponsor: WARREN, Andrews, Nadeau GR Committee Report: ONTP

SUMMARY: The bill required that any subdivider set aside 20% of the subdivision lots below market value. The title and statement of fact indicated that the sale price was to be 25% below market value. However, the actual statutory language indicated that the sale price was to be 25% of fair market value.

LD AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF AIRCRAFT ON UPPER ONTP 935 NARROWS POND IN KENNEBEC COUNTY WHICH IS DESIGNATED AS A RESOURCE FOR PUBLIC DRINKING WATER.

Sponsor: NORTON

Committee Report: ONTP

SUMMARY: The bill prohibited the use of Upper Narrows Pond in Kennebec County by float planes.

LD AN ACT TO REQUIRE MUNICIPAL PERMITS FOR LVWD 940 COMMERCIAL LANDFILLS.

Sponsor: LORD, Murphy E, Ridley Committee Report: LVWD

SUMMARY: The bill required a local permit for the siting of any new or expanded commercial landfills and included this requirement in the set of local land-use laws which can be enforced under the "Rule 80K" provisions authorized in Title 30 §4966. This provision sets up a streamlined enforcement process. See also LD 1862.
