Committee Report: New Draft of LD 162

SUMMARY: This new draft gave the Health Care Finance Commission more flexibility in responding to the concerns expressed by hospitals whose base-year budgets, as approved by the Voluntary Budget Review Organization, are less than the total amount that was actually expended in that year. The bill authorized a new adjustment that may be made to a hospital's financial requirements in the 3rd or subsequent payment year.

SUMMARY: This bill created a commission to examine and propose recommendations to improve the laws concerning the involuntary commitment of substance abusers to treatment programs, including current practices under the laws; the enforcement of current laws; whether the laws apply to the full range of persons intended to be served by the laws; and whether clients' rights are sufficiently recognized and protected. The commission was funded from the Alcohol Premium Fund and staffed by the Department of Human Services.
