LD AN ACT RELATING TO STORAGE AND TRANSPORTATION LVWD 969 OF HIGH-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE WASTE.

Sponsor: SCARPINO, Martin J, Moholland, Theriault Committee Report: LVWD

<u>SUMMARY:</u> The bill authorized the Passamaquoddy Tribe and Penobscot Nation to enact ordinances restricting the the storage and transportation of high-level nuclear waste within their territories. The bill also established requirements for the storage and transportation of high-level nuclear waste anywhere in the state or its coastal waters.

LD AN ACT TO REGULATE DISCHARGES FROM VEHICULAR PL 1987 982 TANKS. C. 163

Sponsor: MITCHELL, Clark N, Clark H, Jacques Committee Report: OTP-A Amendments Adopted: H-120 COMMITTEE

SUMMARY: The bill prohibits the discharge of pollutants from motor vehicles and trailers (eg: recreational vehicles and mobile homes) in any manner that could cause water quality degradation. The committee amendment clearly establishes a civil penalty for the violation of this prohibition.

LD AN ACT CONCERNING FEES IMPOSED ON THE LVWD 983 GENERATION OF HAZARDOUS WASTE.

Sponsor: MITCHELL, Coles Committee Report: LVWD

SUMMARY: The bill established new fees on certain hazardous substances. The committee voted "leave-to-withdraw" after dealing with this topic in other legislation (see LD 836).
