SUMMARY

The bill makes small changes in the laws licensing hearing aid dealers and fitters. It changes the cycle of renewals, allows consumers to pay the full price at the time of purchase, allows licensees to recoup 10% of the cost if a transaction is cancelled, and limits the obligation of licensees to accept a cancellation of a hearing aid order.
