SUMMARY: Provides on exemption equal to 10% of the just value of property which is the primary residence of the taxpayer and has been owned by the taxpayer for at least 15 years.

1134 CONSTITUTION OF MAINE TO ESTABLISH A LIMIT ON
INCREASES IN THE LOCAL PROPERTY TAX

SUMMARY: Proposes a constitutional amendment to limit any increases in either the valuation of property or the local property tax rate. The limit would be the lower of the increase in the federal Consumer Price Index or the increase in real personal ways in the State. The proposal contains a an emergency provision for exceeding allowable limits when approved by 3/5 majority of the legislative body of the municipality.
