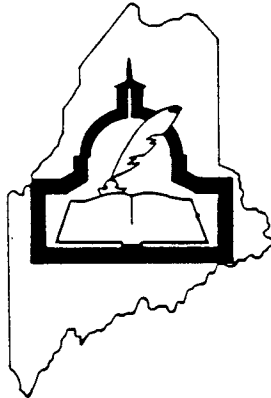

LD AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARITABLE SOLICITATIONS  
1159 LAWS

Committee Report: ONTP

SUMMARY: This bill provides protection for the trademarks of charitable organizations by prohibiting their use by other similar organizations in much the same fashion that these marks are protected for businesses.

Charities that are being subjected to this problem have 2 current recourses.

A. The offended charity has recourse under common law as an unfair trade practice.

B. Registered tradenames and marks are protected under the chapter on Registration and Protection of Trademarks under 10 MRSA Chapter 301-A. A violation of this chapter may be enjoined and the defendant required to pay all profits to the offended organization plus damages.

LD AN ACT TO IDENTIFY THE POTENTIAL HAZARDS OF  
1160 PAINT REMOVAL BY MEANS OF HEAT

Committee Report: LVWD

SUMMARY: This bill requires a warning on packages containing devices to remove paint thru the application of heat that the use of the equipment can cause harmful and toxic fumes. The warning would further advise that the equipment not be used in the presence of children.

LD AN ACT TO REQUIRE ON ALL PURCHASE AND SALE  
1167 AGREEMENTS A DECLARATION OF PRESENCE OR  
ASBESTOS MATERIALS

LVWD

Sponsor: BOST, Nutting, Diamond, Hussey  
Committee Report: LVWD

SUMMARY: This bill requires that deeds executed after Jan. 1, 1988 contain a notice as to the presence of asbestos if the grantor of the deed is aware of such presence.
