Sponsor: WARREN, Kerry Committee Report: ONTP

SUMMARY: The bill authorized the Department of Environmental Protection to assess the costs of needed transportation (road) improvements against the developer of a project only to the extent that the proposed project is directly responsible for the increased traffic. Current departmental regulation under the Site Location of Development Act requires that a developer bring the affected transportation system up to a level that can handle all of the existing traffic and the increase in traffic generated by the proposed development. The committee rejected the bill because of the potential to excacerbate existing traffic problems.

LD AN ACT TO REQUIRE RECORDING OF CERTAIN 1336 SUBDIVISION AND ZONING VARIANCES.

PL 1987 c. 182

Committee Report: OTP

SUMMARY: The bill required that subdivision and zoning variances along with any related conditions be noted on the subdivision plan, if appropriate, and recorded with the registry of deeds within 30 days of the granting of the variance.

LD AN ACT TO CREATE A STUDY OF GROWTH PRESSURES IN LVWD 1369 MAINE COMMUNITIES.

**EMERGENCY** 

Sponsor: MAYO, Soucy, Melendy Committee Report: LVWD

SUMMARY: This bill would have created a 14 member commission to study the relationship between the rapid growth in land use pressures within the state and the tools and mechanics available to communities to manage that growth. Membership on the commission was composed of legislators, state agency representatives and members of the public. The committee voted "leave-to-withdraw" in view of other legislation under consideration (see LD 1762).

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
