LD AN ACT TO EXTEND THE SUNSET PROVISION OF THE PL 1987 1515 MAINE REVISED STATUTES, TITLE 5, SECTION 17004 c. 309

SUMMARY: This bill extended the provisions of the current law which prohibit an insurer from asking if a person has obtained an HIV antibody test. The current provisions were scheduled to sunset on October 1, 1987. This bill extended the sunset date until October 1, 1988.

SUMMARY: This bill authorized the Commissioner of Mental Health and Mental Retardation to extend the employment of Charles E. Meredith as Superintendent of the Bangor Mental Health Institute waiving the restriction in Title 5 which prohibits interchange of governmental employees in excess of 12 months during any 36 month period.

<u>SUMMARY:</u> This bill permits limited administrative disclosure of HIV Antibody Test results in conjunction with Federally mandated military testing program.

1539 ACCESS FOR HANDICAPPED PERSONS TO PUBLIC FACILITIES

SUMMARY: This bill sought to amend the current law regarding construction standards for making facilities accessible to the physically handicapped to reflect newly published specifications and future revisions. The new draft accomplishes that purpose by authorizing the Director

LDAN ACT TO AMEND THE CHILD AND FAMILY SERVICES LVWD 1550 AND CHILD PROTECTION ACT

Sponsor: MCPHERSON, Macomber, Begley, Kerry Committee Report: LVWD

SUMMARY: This bill sought to make several changes to the Child and Family Services and Child Protection Act. Those changes include provisions which make it clearer that out-of-court statements by juveniles are not limited to interviews conducted by the court in chambers, permits optional disclosure of department records to other state agencies, allows court testimony by other children in the household or in another household, and provides for 6 hour interim care of juveniles even when the parents object.

LDRESOLVE, CONCERNING THE TESTING OF SCHOOL INDEF. PP 1563 BUILDINGS FOR RADON

SUMMARY: This bill, and its amendments, would have funded testing of school buildings for radon.

SUMMARY: This bill authorizes and directs the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation to establish rules setting out procedures to be observed in cardiopulmonary resuscitation decision making by personnel at mental health and mental retardation institutions.
