SUMMARY

LD 105 proposed to authorize the reopening of workers' compensation cases where fraud had occurred in the original award of benefits.

Committee Amendment "A" (H-270) restricted the reopening of cases due to fraud by requiring a petition alleging fraud to be filed within one year of the initial award of benefits and further required a showing of due diligence by the petitioner. The amendment also provided that the LD would apply only to injuries occurring on or after the LD's effective date.
