All Adopted Amendments are listed, by paper number (e.g., H-584 or S-222), together with the sponsor for floor amendments. Final action is listed to the right of the title. If final House and Senate action differ, both are listed. Committee Reports and Floor Action are abbreviated as follows:

OTP-ND	Ought to Pass in New Draft
OTP-ND-NT	Ought to Pass in New Draft, New Title
OTP-A	Ought to Pass as Amended
ONTP	Ought Not to Pass

An Act to Prohibit Motor Vehicle Insurers from Adjusting Personal Insurance Rates of Public Works Employees Involved in Collisions

SUMMARY

The bill would prohibit insurers from increasing the personal insurance rates of a public works employee for an accident in the course of employment.

CA (H-378) The amendment modifies the bill so that an insurance company may not surcharge the personal automobile policy of a public works employee or a contractor serving that function for an accident that occurs when driving a municipal vehicle or other vehicle insured separately in the course and scope of employment, to provide a special designation for these offenses on the public works employee's driving record.

LD 695 An Act Regarding the Exclusion of Family Members under a Motor Vehicle Liability Insurance Policy

SUMMARY

Since the courts have increased the availability of lawsuits by family members against the policy owner for injuries sustained in motor vehicle accidents, there is a trend to exclude family members of the household of an insured driver from protection under the liability policy. This bill prohibits exclusion of family members other than spouses, and prohibits exclusion of the actual losses of the spouse.

CA (S-206) This amendment replaces the original bill and simply requires disclosure to the purchaser when an insurance policy excludes liability coverage for family members, with an effective date of January 1, 1990.

LD 726 An Act to Clarify the Reporting Requirements for Workers' Compensation Insurers

AMENDMENTS ADOPTED

SUMMARY

In 1987, the Legislature enacted 24-A MRSa §2371, which contains detailed statistical reporting requirements for workers' compensation insurers. The bill repeals some of the reporting requirements under Title 39, section 107 which are redundant under the new law.

This bill was withdrawn, and the issue addressed in LD 1040.
