SUMMARY

Under the bill, when an all-terrain vehicle is operated on a way it is subject to the provisions of Title 29 except chapter 5, Registration, chapter 7, Operator's License, and chapter 9, Financial Responsibility and Insurance.

CA (H-219) The amendment modifies the bill by exempting ATV's from inappropriate sections of Title 29, including those referring to Titles, Inspections, Motor Vehicle Repair and For-hire Passenger and Freight Carriers.
