SUMMARY

The Sunapee charr, Salvelinus alpinus oquassa, is a rare type of trout which is found in large numbers only in Floods Pond in Otis and nowhere else in the world. This bill, as enacted, authorizes and directs the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife and the Bangor Water District to develop a plan for the protection of the Sunapee charr habitat at Floods Pond. The original bill sought to restrict activities at Floods Pond and within its watershed which would endanger the survival of the Sunapee charr.

SUMMARY

This bill would have required big game hunters to obtain written permission from land owners before hunting on privately owned property, unless the land owner has posted the land indicating that hunting is permitted on that land.
