SUMMARY

Recent amendments to Title 29 limit the issuance of driver's licenses to 15-year olds to special circumstances. This bill amends the law to allow persons who applied for an instruction permit or driver's license up to September 29, 1989 to proceed under the old law.

The Committee Amendment (S-452) adds a fiscal note.
