H-719

SUMMARY

This bill extends the existing regulation of the installation of underground oil tanks over aquifers and near water supplies to the installation of these facilities in the shoreland zone. These requirements apply to all new and replacement underground oil storage tanks. A committee amendment (H-719) delayed the effective date of this bill to September 15, 1989, rather than upon the Governor's signing the bill.

H-727 JACQUES

SUMMARY

This bill modifies recently enacted changes to clarify the procedures to be used by the Land for Maine's Future Board when eminent domain powers are used, to allow the Board to give notice to affected landowners and the public while continuing to operate the program. This bill requires the Board to notify landowners before it designates a property for negotiation. A House amendment (H-727) clarifies that notice shall be given after negotiations have been completed. The bill also amends existing law concerning municipal ratification of eminent domain transactions.
