All Adopted Amendments are listed, by paper number (e.g., H-584 or S-222), together with the sponsor for floor amendments. Final action is listed to the right of the title. Committee Reports and Floor Action are abbreviated as follows:

OTP	Ought to Pass

OTP-ND-NT	Ought to Pass in New Draft, New Title
OTP-A	Ought to Pass as Amended
ONTP	Ought Not to Pass
LVWD	Leave to Withdraw

SUMMARY

LD 1891 clarified the definition of "employer" under the severance pay law to enable employees to collect severance pay due under that law from an employer's corporate parent as well as the immediate employer.

Committee Amendment "A" (S-500) made technical drafting corrections to the bill and made the bill apply retroactively to October 1, 1975.



SUMMARY

LD 1901 proposed to explicitly authorize rehabilitation providers to refer injured employees to job development specialists under the workers' compensation rehabilitation system.

SUMMARY

LD 1908 repealed the sunset clause from the family medical leave law.

ONTP

Committee Amendment "A" (H-821) made the bill an emergency and requires the Bureau of Labor Standards to include a summary of the law's provisions on the standard wage and hour poster provided to all employers in the state.
