The bill expands Medicaid coverage of adult dental services to include preventive, diagnostic and corrective care.

Committee Amendment "A" replaces the original bill. It requires the Department of Human Services to pursue Medicaid waivers which would enable it to offer adult dental services in clinic settings on a demonstration basis.

Senate Amendment "A" amends Committee Amendment "A" to make it clear that the demonstration project would be undertaken with existing funds.

SUMMARY

The bill requires information regarding the Long-Term Care Ombudsman program to be provided to residents of nursing homes and their guardians, and requires that posters regarding the program be mounted in nursing homes.

Committee Amendment "A" adds the requirement that the posters also include the Department of Human Services' rules regarding residents' rights.

SUMMARY

The bill prohibits smoking on all buses except chartered buses.

Committee Amendment "A" removes the chartered bus exemption and thereby prohibits smoking on all buses.

Senate Amendment "A" removes the language of Committee Amendment "A", reverting the bill to its original form, including the exemption for chartered buses.
