SUMMARY

The bill, as amended by the committee amendment, repeals a sunset provision affecting the Department of Marine Resources' authority to collect a fee for issuing ID tags for lobster traps owned by participants in the Swan's Island trap limit program.

SUMMARY

This bill, as amended by the committee amendment, requires the Commissioner of Marine Resources to consult with the municipal shellfish conservation committee before opening a shellfish area in a municipality for depuration digging. The commissioner may continue to allow depuration digging without notifying municipalities in areas that were open to depuration digging on September 1, 1989. The bill also requires the Department of Marine Resources to bring together a group of municipal representatives and interested citizens to discuss methods for increasing the local role in water quality testing. The department will report its findings to the Legislature.

The bill allows the shipment of sardine cans containing fewer than 4 fish to markets in the territories and possessions of the United States, but retains the prohibition on sale of these cans in the United States.
