The bill amends the statutes regarding ASPIRE to conform with the federal requirements of the Family Support Act.

Committee Amendment "A" makes additional changes to the ASPIRE law to further address compliance with the Family Support Act.

SUMMARY

Under current law, the Division of Driver Education Evaluation must certify to the Secretary of State when a driver has completed a mandatory Driver Education Evaluation program. The bill specifies that the certification must be made within 10 days of the driver completing the program.

SUMMARY

This bill would have established requirements for local zoning ordinances relating to day care facilities. Registered or licensed children's day care facilities serving 12 or fewer children would have been a permitted use in all areas zoned for residential use.

In addition, the bill would have provided for uniformity between local and state licensing of children's day care facilities.

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
