## **SUMMARY**

LD 2307 requires that the Board of Trustees of the Maine Technical College System receive the approval of the Legislature before transferring any interest in real estate held by the Technical College System.

Committee Amendment "A" to LD 2307 clarified that the intent of the bill was to establish legislative oversight of permanent transfer of title to real estate, not to require oversight for rental or lease agreements entered into by the Technical College System. The amendment clarified that intent by substituting the phrase "permanently transferred" for the word "transferred".

## SUMMARY

LD 2312 implemented the recommendations of the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government's interim subcommittee study of the substance abuse service delivery system.

The bill establishes an Office of Substance Abuse within the Executive branch. The Office is responsible for several functions previously performed by the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Planning Committee and the Office of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention, including the responsibility of adopting a comprehensive plan for the delivery of alcohol and drug abuse delivery services, developing a unified budget for all expenditures by state agencies related to alcohol and drug abuse prevention services, approving and
